12. How is democracy better than other forms of government? Explain giving at least five arguments in the favour of democracy.

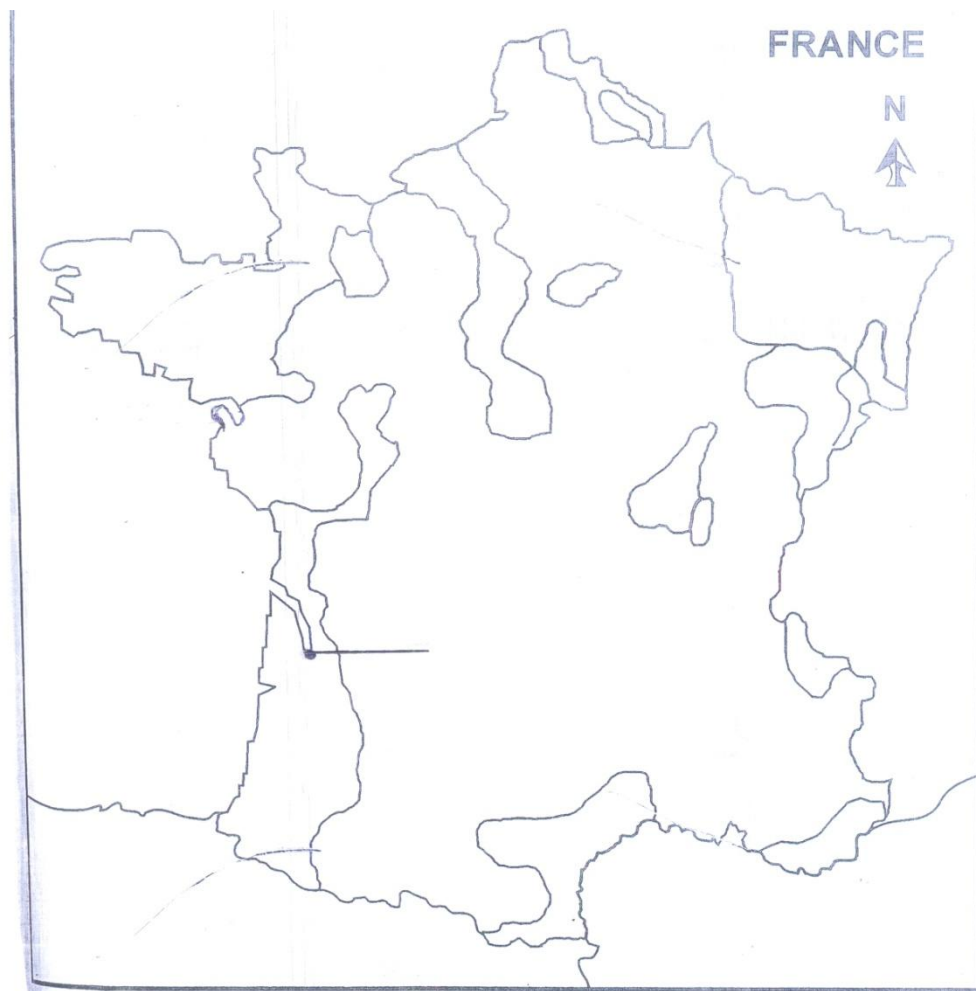
13. Why is health of a person given so importance? What has the government done in this direction? What are its results?
